

Before the opening

WHAT









HOW

- Open the filter/peel door (9) and remove the filter to check for seeds or pulp. Clean by extracting the remains into the waste bin.
- 2. Insert the tap return box (8) to place it in the dosing position. The machine will then be ready to juice.
- 3. Insert (12) empty waste bin with double bag
- 4. Open the upper loading door (13), fill the hopper with oranges until it is full.

WHAT







HOW

- 1. Empty the waste bin, if it is full. Feed more oranges if hopper is empty.
- 2. Clean juicer door glass (7) with a damp single-use paper.
- 3. Clean the drip area (10) with a cloth and Citric Active[®].



End-of-Day Cleaning

Before starting the automatic sanitization process

WHAT



HOW

- Open the juicer door (7) and remove the oranges contained in the feeder tube.
 Check the peel outlet area for any peel inside and if necessary, remove it.
- 3. Remove the waste bin and visually check that there is a level of detergent to perform the cleaning. Then insert the bin again.





HOW

1. Access the Main Menu by pressing the Display for a few seconds and entering PIN 1217.

2. Access the Cleaning Menu, then click on Sanitization.

3. Extract the return box from the tap to place it in the wash position.

4. Press Start.

WHAT







HOW

1. Wait 1 minute until the Pulpout system extracts the last pulp contained in the filter. When the display tells you to, open the filter/peel door (9). To clean these areas, spray the surfaces with Citric Active[©]. Leave on for at least 3 minutes and then remove the remains of pulp using a damp cloth or brush.

Note: For safety, the cleaning process will be interrupted while the filter/peel door is open.

2. Remove the waste bin.

HOW

Capsule base: at the end of the sanitization process, also remove the Pulpout filter and the juice container and check the capsule base for any peel inside and if necessary, remove them. Then clean with a damp cloth.

Squeezing Capsule Cleaning

WHAT





HOW





Capsule deep cleaning: Disassemble the juicing unit to
carry out a thorough cleaning of the non-removable
elements of the capsule as follows:

- 1. Open the juicer door (7) Remove the pressing units in pairs by first unscrewing the knobs that hold them. Lift the peel ejector and pull out the three pieces by sliding through the shaft.
- 2. Then remove the peel ejector by gently pulling them away from the drum.
- 3. Remove the PulpOut system by lifting the front part first until it is removed from its shaft (5)
- 4. Disassemble the juice container (6) by lifting it from position and removing it from the capsule.




Squeezing Capsule Cleaning

WHAT









HOW

Capsule deep cleaning: Clean non-removable elements: Shafts, stainless front, blade, capsule base and upper inner part of capsule. Use a cloth with warm water and soap, for later rinsing.

WARNING! Take extra care when cleaning the blade to avoid cuts or damage.

Assemble the disassembled parts in reverse order, paying special attention to the assembly of the pressing units together with the peel ejector. Raise the peel ejector by inserting it into the shaft so that it is placed in its correct position (A). If the peel ejector is detached showing the ball of the lower pressing unit, it will not be fixed correctly (B).

Cleaning other modules

WHAT





HOW

1. Cleaning the lifting tower: Carry out the cleaning of the lifting tower and door to remove any wax residues that may have been generated by the oranges fed to the machine. Then open the lift tower door and spray the belt surfaces and buckets with Zumex Citric Active®. Leave on for at least 3 minutes and then remove using a wellwrung out wet cloth until rinsing off traces of cleaning product. Remove the tray from the base of the lifter, empty any debris and clean it in the same way. 2. Orange hopper cleaning: Open the front door of the hopper, remove the brakes to the front hopper wheels and remove the hopper to clean it in the area you want. Start by spraying the surfaces of hopper with Zumex Citric Active[©]. Leave on for at least 3 minutes and then remove using a cloth wet until rinsed of traces of cleaning product. Wipe inside the furniture with a cloth afterwards well drained.
